

## BOJAN VULETIC

Bojan Vuletic is a composer, musical director, producer, writer of lyrics and performing guitarist. After a diploma in astro-physics at *Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität* in München, he finished jazz-guitar at the *Hogeschool voor de Kunsten* in Arnhem and composition at the *Messiaen-Akademie*, Netherlands. In his works he seeks artistic interdisciplinary discourse with artists from the fields of music, art, dance, theatre, film and literature. These intensive collaborations manifest in a very different artistic forms, composed and improvised in performances and installations at traditional art venues and in public space.

As a composer, guitarist and musical director he has worked together with a large variety of chamber music ensembles, orchestras, choirs, bands and Jazz-Bigbands.

Bojan Vuletic received the music award 2012 of the city of Düsseldorf and was 2014 - 16 the artistic-musical director of *Junges Schauspielhaus Düsseldorf*. Since 2012 he directs the annual and interdisciplinary *ASPHALT Festival* together with theatre director Christof Seeger-Zurmühlen, which was founded by them.

In 2016-17 he is guest researcher and substitute for professor *Danica Dakić* in the MFA-program *Public Art and New Artistic Strategies* at *Bauhaus-Universität* Weimar.
