BOJAN VULETIĆ

Bojan Vuletic is a composer, musical director, producer, writer of lyrics and performing guitarist. After a diploma in astro-physics at *Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität* in München, he finished jazzguitar at the *Hogeschool voor de Kunsten* in Arnhem and composition at the *Messiaen-Akademie*, Netherlands. In his works he seeks artistic interdisciplinary discourse with artists from the fields of music, art, dance, theatre, film and literature. These intensive collaborations manifest in a very different artistic forms, composed and improvised in performances and installations at traditional art venues and in public space.

As a composer, guitarist and musical director he has worked together with a large variety of chamber music ensembles, orchestras, choirs, bands and Jazz-Bigbands.

His most recent full length premieres include 'ALL QUIET ON THE WAR FRONT', 'Visions of Excess' und 'I hear you' as well as 'Flügel, schwebend' and ,Zweig und Eselin' both commissioned by *Tonhalle Düsseldorf*:

Vuletić realized exhibitions in cooperation with other artists and solo e. g. at documenta 12 Kassel, Liverpool Biennial of Contemporary Art 2010 and Biennale di Venezia 2019, at KIT Düsseldorf 2013 and 2023.

He composed music and sound for more than 60 contemporary dance and theatre pieces and was musical director for two RUHR2010 projects in collaboration with *Duisburger Philharmoniker* as well as for the festivals *Nordisk Ungdoms Filmfestival Tromsø* 2008 & 2012 and *Tromsø Internasjonale Filmfestival* 2009 (Norway).

Bojan Vuletic received the music award 2012 of the city of Düsseldorf and was 2014 - 16 the artistic-musical director of *Junges Schauspielhaus Düsseldorf*.

Since 2012 he directs the annual and interdisciplinary ASPHALT Festival together with theatre director Christof Seeger-Zurmühlen, which was founded by them.

In 2016-17 he was guest researcher and substitute for professor Danica Dakić in the MFAprogram *Public Art and New Artistic Strategies* at Bauhaus-Universität Weimar.
